Moe also has extensive behavior education having served as the behaviorist for the Humane Society Silicon Valley for over 12 years.

Being an agility fanatic for twelve years now, she has put the highest AKC and USDAA titles on four different breeds: Boxer, Border Collie, Mini Aussie and Whippet. She currently coaches teams ranging from Rhodesian Ridgebacks to Shiba Inus to Airedales to all Americans. She has competed for numerous years at nationals in USDAA, AKC and UKI. She recently won her spot onto the WAO Team USA for 2012. She will be competing in Belgium in May 2012 with her six year old border collie Kindle, with her five year old border collie Kyna as an alternate member.

Moe started her own business, Momentum Dog Sports in 2006 after teaching for Power Paws Agility for over five years. She continues to teach for Power Paws in San Jose and ACE Dog Sports in San Francisco as she grows her own business. Moe has taught numerous years at Power Paws Summer Camp and Clean Run Instructor Camp. She has also written numerous articles for [Clean Run Magazine](#). She currently travels throughout North America teaching agility workshops and seminars.

Moe emphasizes consistency, play, essential analysis, humor, and continuous teamwork. She can empathize with the handler who is not always physically capable to “run” but helps teams build vital distance skills early in their partnership to provide the same success as “younger” teams.
